

Description of ritual ancestral constellations (biological ancestors)

1: The thematic ritual ancestral constellation. The constellation for a situation.

2: The general ritual ancestral constellation from both parents (2a) or from a single parent (2b). The large or small constellation of trust.

3: The combination constellation in the line of a parent. The maternal or paternal constellation.

4: The combination constellation in the line of a grandparent. The maternal or paternal grandparent constellation.

5: The broad constellation from both parents (5a) or from a single parent (5b). The large or small broad constellation.

* means a stone.

Numbers indicate the order in which stones are placed.

Letters in bold indicate that it has been agreed upon in advance that this stone will be picked up, tuned into and represented.

Specific, that is to say, a card will be placed next to it indicating exactly which ancestor this is in the ancestral line.

Dormant means that it has been agreed upon in advance that this stone will not be picked up, tuned into or represented.

Ritual ancestor constellation 1: the thematic ritual ancestor constellation.

The constellation for a situation.

** means a stone.*

Numbers indicate the order in which stones are placed.

Letters in bold indicate that it has been agreed upon in advance that this stone will be picked up, tuned into and represented.

Specific, that is to say, a card will be placed next to it indicating exactly which ancestor this is in the ancestral line.

Dormant means that it has been agreed upon in advance that this stone will not be picked up, tuned into or represented.

Tuning in and representing takes place in the order of laying. The first five generations are tuned into and represented.

The parent and grandparent are determined (specific). This is indicated with cards.

The two ancestors of the third generation are both represented. It is left to the ancestors to decide which of the two will come forward in the middle stone and thus be represented first.

Ritual ancestor constellation 2a: the general ancestor constellation from both parents.

The grand constellation of trust.

Numbers indicate the order in which stones are placed.

Letters in bold indicate that it has been agreed upon in advance that this stone will be picked up, tuned into and represented.

Specific, that is to say, a card will be placed next to it indicating exactly which ancestor this is in the ancestral line.
